Dear Mr. Huisman:

I am Joe Baptista the founder and official representative of the Public-Root. It is a pleasure to acknowledge that Tiscali selected the Public-Root this past July 26 2005 as its official root service provider. I have attached the Tiscali press release on this to refresh your memory.

Unfortunately, I find myself in a position in which I must warn you that the decision by Tiscali to resolve the Public-Root was premature and a mistake. The error in my opinion is the fault of your company in failing to do their due diligence on the Public-Root. If your company had followed standard business practices, they would have discovered what I found in my investigation of the people who were trusted with the administration of the Public-Root.

They would have found that these people, namely one Herman Xennt and another Marcel Bor are associated with terrorist organizations, fraud and hacking. In this case, the association is to one George Green a member of the IRA (Irish Republican Army). In addition, a simple crosscheck of the people associated with the Public-Root would have shown that hackers known to the Netherlands Police operate the root service now used by Tiscali users.

This is all very unfortunate but it is more unfortunate if your company does nothing to rectify this. I suggest you proceed to investigation this and change your root servers A.S.A.P. If you do nothing Tiscali users will remain at risk of having their privacy and security compromised.

As I have pointed out in the past, root servers can be used to intercept or redirect Internet transactions. This means a users security and privacy can be easily compromised. Today Tiscali has signed an agreement with UNIDT (Unified Identity Technology), an international top level domain administrator, giving all Tiscali subscribers



access to a new generation of internet "Top Level Domains (TLD's)". Top Level Domain names are the letters or words following the dot in a website address. UNIDT allows companies to register domains such as .Tiscali or .KPMG without needing to enter the traditional internet domains (such as .com/.org/.net), or country codes (such as .nl/.be/.de) and without needing to type "www."

As a result of this agreement, Tiscali will offer to its subscribers across Europe the access to the entire World Wide Web, including the new alternative domain names. The agreement underscores Tiscali's commitment to embrace technological developments that simplify, improve and expand the opportunities offered by internet.

With public TLD's (Ptd) anyone can register any desired term, such as ".wine", ".tickets" or ".forsale". Corporate TLD's (Ctd) enable companies to make their web address synonymous with their name. For companies, the new Top Level Domain structure offers additional opportunities to profile themselves and to manage the traffic to their websites more effectively. The new TLD Structure means that an infinite amount of secondary domain names can be registered, such as "contact.unidt", "helpdesk.unidt" or "subscribe.unidt". Instead of going to the UNIDT homepage,

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UNIDT users and visitors can directly navigate towards the information they are looking for.

In Italy/Germany/UK the possibility to access these new domains will be active starting from September.

While, in the Netherlands Tiscali customers can already access to this new generation domains. Moreover, Tiscali Netherlands is one of the first companies to have registered a corporate TLD (home.tiscali). Other large companies are KPMG, TomTom and many more.
